The project description is Fourth Street from N West Street to N Main Street
Union Street from E Fourth Street to E Beech Street.

Culy Contracting, LLC submitted a bid for Street paving in the amount of \$132,567.00.

Mr. Richmond moved to award the bid submitted from Culy Contracting, LLC, application #4580. Mr. McCoy seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

The project description is Sixth Street from N West Street to N. Meridian Street.
